These batteries are particularly safe because sodium is less reactive than lithium and not prone to dendrite formation (short circuit risk). Other contributing factors are the higher availability and therefore greater environmental friendliness, as no rare, toxic, or difficult-to-extract materials are required. The sodium-ion technology also boasts outstanding results in low temperatures. And finally, the cost structure is also advantageous.

On account of the excellent energy density, however, the BMZ Group will continue to produce battery cells and batteries based on lithium-ion technology. The lithium-ion technology will continue to lead the way for all applications in which battery space is critical.
